


tremendous work done by Rtn Chitranjan IFCR 3291 Kolkatta and Rtn Rajesh Thapa, Chairman IFCR Nepal.

From a Business into an Organisation

The prime responsibility of every businessman is to evolve his business into an organization. What's the difference between a business and an organization? A person runs a business. Systems and people within those systems run an organization. A business is managed while an organization is led. In business that one man remains the strength and weakness of the business. If it is an organization, the weaknesses in the systems can be eliminated, strength and efficiency could be



added to the system and most importantly more and more competent men can be added into the organization to work within the system. Businesses are constrained by the physical limitations of the person, whereas systems have no such physical constraints. There is a limit to how much a man can stretch, but the scope to expand systems is limitless. It is the responsibility of every business head and the department heads within every organization to create systems, which would make at least a part of you dispensable.

In the early stages of one's working life, success is defined by the ability to produce eight hours of productivity by working for eight hours. As you grow, you should be able to work for eight hours and produce eighty hours of productivity. That is, now you have evolved a system through which you are able to produce eight hours of productivity from ten different people. Then it has to evolve to eight hundred hours and from then on to eight thousand hours of productivity and so on... This, in essence, is the growth of a leader from being a manager and this, in essence, is developing an organization from being just a business.

The fundamental key to building an organisation is shift that is needed in the attitude of the head of any organisation. People are too sentimental and their position. Only if you let people to step in and come up in the ladder of your success, as they raise themselves, you will automatically go up another rung in the ladder. Anything you wish to transcend in life you must be willing to lose it. Let us be very clear that the ultimate objective of building any organisation is to ensure maximum growth for maximum people in maximum possible ways. Do not get too attached to your methodology of working and lose sight of your vision. Please do not be a bottleneck to your own vision. Everybody cannot have a vision with a sense of grandeur, which you have. There are enough people who can work and let them work through your system towards your vision. Be ready to make a part of yourself in your work dispensable, be willing to bring more hands, more legs and more intelligence to work on your objectives.
