Speaker Meet on Emerging markets - International scenario on 07.04.07



The speaker Mr. Sunil Sachan is with Booz Allen Hamilton and consulting a lot of IT companies in India including Hyderabad on behalf of NASSCOM. He showed through a power point presentation the opportunities and strengths of India vis a vis some South Asian countries and also European countries. He also talked about the weakness and threats to India as an emerging global economic player. He felt that we are in an advantageous position now but if the government does not improve infrastructure we will stand to loose that advantage.
