## **Joint Meet & Club Visit by Rtn. Polish President on 02.12.06**

Rtn. Krzysztof addressed the club describing the various community projects undertaken by his Rotary Club.

The club was then addressed by the other guest President from South Africa, Rtn. Robert Xavier from RC Bottorworth of district 9270. It was interesting to listen and understand the conditions under which they had to work in South Africa and the adversities that they were trying to overcome. In his address, he illustrated the importance of using the word "please". He even regaled the members with an impromptu magic act with his scarf.

The presidents ended their address with the customary exchange of flags, banners, rotary pins etc.

## **Community Service at Vikasini Girls School on 05.12.06**



During the visit of our Rotarian guest from Poland, Rtn. President Krzysztof Milczarek, our community service director Rt. Ramayya organized a community services project of distribution of shoes to all the 87 students attending the Vikasini School for Girls, Addagutta, Secunderabad. Rotarians Ramayya, Chandrasekhar, Amarnath, Anns Vijaylakshmi, and Tanvi were present from our club. After the distribution of shoes, Chandrasekhar donated his promised cooking oil for the month on that day. President Krzysztof and Ann Tanvi also donated Rs. 1,500/- each for the payments of Milk and Horlicks which would suffice them for the next two months.

## **Joint Speaker Meet with RC Hyderabad Midtown on 09.12.06**



This was joint meet held with RC Hyderabad Midtown at Hotel Taj Tristar. The guest speaker for the day, Dr. D. R. Prasad Raju from BYRAJU Foundation, spoke about the problems regarding Fluoride (Nalgonda District) and other contaminations in the water in some of the rural areas. He laid emphasis that clean drinking water was not available to the rural masses due to which people were suffering from ill health and the efforts taken by the foundation to take about 155 villages into their umbrella of help. They were seeking help from the Rotary clubs as partners in their endeavor as both the organizations had similar goals. They have already executed one project with the support of Twin cities Rotary Clubs.

## **District Pulse Polio Seminar on 10.12.06**

RC of Hyderabad East hosted this District event. The, Honorable Health Minister, Shri. K. Rossiah inaugurated the meet. Rtn. U. Ravi Rao chaired the meeting. RI Director Elect, Rtn. Ashok Mahajan, was the chief guest for the event. Member, National Pulse Polio Committee, D Varda Reddy also graced the occasion. All the other dignitaries present (including DG Sam, PDG Ravi Vadlamani and others) in their address emphasized the need of the immunization drive, as it was very important that the world is free of any polio cases in the coming year. It was informed that there were 583 polio cases detected in India, 95% of them in and around the state of Uttar Pradesh. There were absolutely no cases in Andhra Pradesh but still we could lay our guard down. It would be possible only with the involvement of as many people as possible. Hence all Rotarians in their full numbers were requested to be present on the National Immunization Dates, i.e., 7<sup>th</sup> January and 11<sup>th</sup> February 2007 for supervising the events.



## Speaker Meet on 16.12.06



The talk was about “Safe Hex” - Computer Security and Viruses from the perspective of the PC user. The speaker, Mr. Govind Menon from Ms. Indax Internet Services, talked about the basic precautions that a normal computer user has to take while using their PC's. He gave some Do's and Don'ts while browsing and checking E-mails. The talk was an eye opener and the members realized the dangers that PC users can encounter especially while using the Internet.
