The \$600,000 initiative, \$300,000 of which came from a Rotary Foundation disaster response grant, was the first joint project between the two organizations after a July agreement to collaborate. Rotary members are also working with Ukraine Friends to rehabilitate two schools in the Bucha region damaged by shelling. 
Project Cheetah aims at relocating the African cheetah to India in a collaborative effort of Government of India and Namibia's Cheetah Conservation Foundation (CCF). Cheetah is the only extinct of all the big cats found in India, which completely got extinct in 1952 due to over-hunting. India has embarked on this ambitious project to restore its lost living heritage in the form of African Cheetah.

When the project was considered, Kuno National Park (KNP) in Madhya Pradesh was considered the best site for bringing in the cheetahs. It was rated and ranked high for a number of reasons like:

- 1. The forest area comprises of open woodlands, open grasslands, dry deciduous forests and evergreen riverine forest, making it suitable for the cheetahs of Africa by having them the similar habitat they move in from.
- 2. KNP is spread over the area of 784 sq. kms and is part of larger Sheopur-Shivpuri dry deciduous forest which is very huge.
- 3. According to the survey and research, given the resources in the park it has potential to support 21 cheetahs.
- 4. Prey base is good. It has in abundance, a variety of antelopes like chital, sambhar, nilgai, Chinkara and blackbuck to name a few.
- 5. The climatic conditions are similar to that of Africa considering the hot summers, adequate rains and cool winters.
- 6. There is historical evidence that cheetahs once existed in this forest in the past hence could survive and sustain again.
- 7. Right now this park is only having leopards amongst big cats. There was a tiger that strayed from Ranthambore National Park but it has returned back. So there is enough ground for establishing territories for cheetahs without conflict from other cats.
- 8. There is no human settlements/interference in the park as against many other parks in the country.

Relocation of Cheetah in India






A total of eight fully vaccinated cheetahs were relocated and moved in on 17th of September'22 giving shape to this iconic and ambitious project of great ecological importance. The cheetahs are fitted with satellite collars and are constantly monitored by a capable team of veterinary doctors, naturalists, zoologists and locals. The project is headed by zoologist Laurie Marker from CCF of Namibia. They are kept quarantined in a small enclosure initially to check their suitability for the new habitat, for monitoring signs of infections or any other medical conditions and for acclimatisation. Recently 2 male cheetahs were released in larger enclosure as a second step and the suit will follow gradually for all the cheetahs based upon the success of the two already released. The first kill by the two was a celebrated event across nation making headlines and receiving grand applause.

It is a giant step to undertake a project of this enormity which involves huge financial costs, the success of which could not be predicted soon. The success of the project depends on multiple factors and is difficult to predict now. Researchers say that it is only by the end of five years from now that the success/failure could be judged. Based upon the success of this project there are plans to replicate the same at other locations in India. **Until then let's stay hopeful for a new era to dawn, a new star to shine and a new hope to emerge.**
