Dear Members.

"A very effective 6 months" is what I belive have gone by..... and.... obviously expecting the same for the next 6 months as well.

We have completed in the current year -

5 fellowships.

6 regular monthly e-bulletins

greeting all members on their birthdays and anniversaries.

We shall be having a Vocational visit, Vocational Awards, CSR meet and a family fellowship of night kite flying at Begam Bazar in the immediate future.

DG's interaction with the board and later with RCSS members included his appreciation of various areas where we as a club have reached and to take inspiration to drive further. He gave to a pat on the back to guiding two Interact clubs, which are self sustaining and paying their club dues themselves. He said we are the only club in the whole district to have 22 CSR donors which support our projects. On inspection of our last few projects, during the day, he ascertained the fact that the machinery that we have supplied/donated in the last year or two had actually reduced the time frame from 15 / 21 days to 1 to 4 days. Thus enabling to identify if a patient is suffering from the type of cancer and start treatment asap. He was clear that we are the leaders in the CSR field in the district. But wanted us to get recognised for the work that we are doing under CSR by routing the funds though Rotary. We need to pay an extra 5% for the same, but a certification can be provided from Rotary, where as currently nothing is being given to the donors. The donors can use the milage from such certifications in their businesses. He emphasized the need of getting some of these projects under Global Grants as well, this utilizing the funds even better.

The DG literally said that the club had preformed way above par in the areas of:

Community service/ CSR projects (1.1 cr worth projects with 22 donors),

Membership (12 members or 26.67% increase),

Foundation (100% EREY, 16 PHF, 4 PHS, 12000 approx funds),

International & Public Image (Monthly e-bulletins reaching 5 continents) and

The fantastic family Fellowships that we organise.

Taking inspiration from all the above areas, all of RCSS members have to continue the good work and keep striving to achieving greater heights than already achieved. We also need to heed DG's good advice of one of club member's to become a District Governor in next few years.

Kudos to each and every member of the club. But we cannot rest on the laurels that we have achieved cause

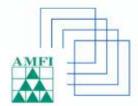

30 January is World Leprosy Day

World Leprosy Day is observed every year on the last Sunday of January. In India, it is observed on 30 January every year, coinciding with the death anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.

Leprosy is a neglected tropical disease (NTD) which still occurs in more than 120 countries, with more than 200 000 new cases reported every year.

The aim of observing the World Leprosy Day is to create awareness against the stigma attached to the disease, by making the general community aware that it is a disease spread by a type of bacteria and it can be easily cured.

Overview

Leprosy, also known as Hansen's disease, is a chronic infectious disease caused by Mycobacterium leprae. The disease affects the skin, the peripheral nerves, mucosal surfaces of the upper respiratory tract and the eyes. Leprosy is known to occur at all ages ranging from early childhood to old age. Leprosy is curable and treatment during early stages can prevent disability.

Leprosy is transmitted via droplets, from the nose and mouth, during close and frequent contact with untreated cases.

Symptoms

Symptoms may occur within one year but can also take as long as 20 years or even more to occur.

The disease manifests commonly through skin lesion and peripheral nerve involvement. Leprosy is diagnosed by finding at least one of the following cardinal signs: (1) definite loss of sensation in a pale (hypopigmented) or reddish skin patch; (2) thickened or enlarged peripheral nerve, with loss of sensation and/or weakness of the muscles supplied by that nerve; (3) presence of acid-fast bacilli in a slit-skin smear.

Skin lesion has usually a different pigmentation than the surrounding normal skin (less pigmented, reddish or copper-coloured) and may have various aspects (flat, raised or nodules). Skin lesion can be single or multiple with a definite loss of sensation.

Leprosy is a highly variable disease, affecting different people in different ways, according to their immune response. Those at one end of the spectrum, with a high level of immunity, harbour a low number of bacilli and are referred to as patients with PB leprosy. Those with many bacilli in the body are referred to as patients with MB leprosy.

Paucibacillary (PB) case: a case of leprosy with 1 to 5 skin lesions, without demonstrated presence of bacilli in a skin smear.

Multibacillary (MB) case: a case of leprosy with more than five skin lesions; or with nerve involvement (pure neuritis, or any number of skin lesions and neuritis); or with the demonstrated presence of bacilli in a slit-skin smear, irrespective of the number of skin lesions.

Treatment

Early diagnosis and complete treatment with multidrug therapy (MDT) remain the key strategies for reducing the disease burden of leprosy.

The 2018 Guidelines for the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of leprosy published by WHO, recommends the same 3-drug regimen with rifampicin, dapsone and clofazimine for all leprosy patients, with a duration of treatment of 6 months for PB leprosy and of 12 months for MB leprosy.

Ranjay then took us to a tour to his premises. He showed us why he is one of the leaders in supply of specific alloy steel in Hyderabad. He actually had stocks in this premises alone of 80000 tones in different kinds of alloy steels. He also explained how they maintain the different kind of stocks, even going into the detailing of where it had been procured from. This is because they need to maintain thatonce supplied to their customers, it should not fail once it is processed and hardened. If any such failure occurs, then the same needs to replaced to the customer.

He has 2 automatic and 4 semi automatic cutting machines which do the cutting as per the requirement of his clients. He also shared some unique stories that he was able to satisfy his customers requirements due to the sheer size and quality of work which can be undertaken by him. He has stocks from 15mm round to about 600mm dia that he can process. All of us were kind of mesmerised with the sheer weight that they handle along with what all were the specific requirements of various engineering companies.

We then sat down for some questions which Ranjay and Anuradha were more than welcome to answer.


