
The cultural performances exhibited by them was no less than ordinary children inspite of their disabilities.


We forget that at the end of the day 'individual' ideas carve a journey towards fulfilling our desires. Else, we live others lives.



Rotary Club WhatsApp Group – Guidelines (Proposed). (Before posting let the four way test guide your group interactions)

✓ Do's

- 1. Share Rotary Updates Only Meetings, events, service projects, and announcements.
- 2. Be Respectful Maintain courtesy and a positive Rotary spirit.
- 3. Use Clear Messages Keep posts short, easy to read, and relevant.
- 4. Confirm Attendance Reply promptly to event invitations or polls. WhatsApp polls to be used for opinions/feedback and event attendance instead of multiple messages spamming the group
 - 5. Post Official Notices Use group for verified information only.
 - 6. Encourage Participation Motivate members to join activities.
 - 7. Use Emojis / Media Wisely Support communication but keep it professional.
 - 8. Avoid Posting at ODD hours.
 - 9. Condense messages as one message instead of sending multiple one sentence posts

⊗Don'ts

- 1. No Spam Avoid unrelated forwards, ads, or chain messages.
- 2. No Politics / Religion Debates Keep discussions neutral and Rotary-focused.
- 3. No Overposting Avoid flooding the group with repeated or non-urgent messages.
- 4. No Personal Messages Use private chat for one-to-one discussions.
- 5. No Sharing Without Source Only post confirmed information.

"Dear Members, this WhatsApp group is for Rotary communication only. Please follow the Do's & Don'ts above so we maintain clarity, respect, and efficiency. Thank you for keeping this space useful for all."
