

Promote peace through Rotary

Rotary Peace Centers have trained more than 1,800 Rotary Peace Fellows since 2002. In June, Rotary announced its next peace center, to be located at Symbiosis International University in Pune, Maharashtra, India. The center will offer a one-year professional development certificate program to train peace and development professionals from across Asia in peace studies, conflict transformation, and sustainable development. For International Peace Day, 21 September, support Rotary's peace efforts and the peace centers in any of these ways:

- Designate a district Rotary Peace Fellowship subcommittee chair for 2025-26 to recruit and mentor peace and development candidates from local communities to apply for Rotary Peace Fellowships.
- Become a Global Peacebuilder District by contributing US\$25,000 in District Designated Funds (DDF) or district cash this Rotary year to support the Rotary Peace Centers or the area of focus in peacebuilding and conflict prevention.

Each year, The Rotary Foundation selects one large-scale, evidence-based, successful project to receive a Programs of Scale award. The 2025 grant recipient is Pathways to Peace and Prosperity in Colombia. This Rotary-led initiative will establish Positive Peace hubs in four urban and rural communities. The hubs will strengthen people's capacity to resolve conflicts while addressing social exclusion, food insecurity, and poverty caused by prolonged violence and armed conflict.

Foundation Trustees also endorsed two finalists: Improving Maternal and Infant Care in Uganda and Mental Health Support for Youth in Florida (United States). The Rotary members who lead these programs are committed to expanding them through global grants. My 'burning' inputs can power a way of life.


Parenting is about giving light.


