Sankalpam the District Assembly was hosted by RC Secunderabad on 27th May at Taramati Baradari. A record 10 members from our club attended the Assembly.

Rtn. Ravi Vadlamani explained the objective of the District Assembly and the importance of leadership and its change every year. He emphasized that every Rotarian can contribute irrespective of him holding an office or not.

Rtn. Sam (DG) discussed the various themes of the past DG's and how the themes help in putting the Rotary Priorities in perspective. He also dwelt on the current year theme

"Lead the Way" and the theme for year 07-08 " Resolve ". He said the District Target was a net membership increase of 10% and increase in Rotary Foundation Contributions. The strength of Paul Harris Society members has increased to 28.

He addressed the gathering and said that Sankalpam (Resolve) means commitment to the cause of Rotary. He mesmerized the delegates with his dedication and conviction. To end his address he explained the 13 edicts to be followed to become an ideal Rotarian and a better Human being. He was given a standing ovation by the delegates.



RCSS to execute its first WCS Project

RCSS has tied up with Rotary Club of Poznan Puszczykowo, District 2230, Poland, under the World Community Service Projects Exchange (WCS) to provide Basic Amenities to the Zilla Parishad High School (Pochamma Wada) in Yadgirgutta village of Nalgonda District.



The project costing more than Rs. 1.5 Lacs would help in providing much needed Tables and Benches for the school children who are currently studying by squatting on the floor and suffering from Bad Posture and Concentration.

The project would directly benefit about 300 under-priviledged students every year. This school caters to children of a small village with a population of about 3,500The project basically aims at improving the Study conditions of the students and assisting the boys and girls in becoming responsible citizens of tomorrow.
