Rotary Cricket Fellowship was organized by Rtn. Sarathy, District Chair IFCR on 1st and 2nd March 2008 at Hyderabad with District 3020. Rotarian Cricketers from 3020 from Vijayawada came to Hyderabad and played two 20-20 matches.
